



NMAHA HANDS & HOOVES INCENTIVE PROGRAM RULES

NMAHA Hands & Hooves Incentive Program. Being fond of the Arabian horse does not just apply to showing, parades or competitive trail riding. NMAHA has added an additional incentive program for all who spend time with a registered Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian from January 1st to November 25th. Amateurs & Professionals alike are eligible, welcome & encouraged to enroll in this additional program!

NMAHA wants to reward you for time spent grooming, farm/ranch work with your horse, taking “riding” lessons, groundwork, training/schooling your horse, trail riding, fun shows or pleasure riding/driving in a non-official competition setting, (excluding: stall cleaning, chores, feeding, etc.)

Time spent doing these activities shall be kept in full and one-quarter hour increments, such as 2.25 or 1.5 hours. Points are awarded as 1 hour = 1 Point.

Each horse used will have to be registered with the Arabian Horse Association. You can use as many horses as you would like and you do not have to be the registered owner, but you, the participant, must be a NMAHA Member, (associate memberships are not accepted). For every horse that is entered, the participant will need to send a copy of the registration papers.

There are 2 age divisions: 17 & Under and 18 & Over. An award for high point in each age division will be given, as well as participation awards. Points will be accumulated from January 1st to November 25th. The year-end awards ceremony will take place at the March meeting, the following year.
