# <u> April 2023</u>

# Royalty Program:

Jaime L. gave an update on the Royalty.

- 2024 Royalty
  - -Jaime L. presented changes/additions that she felt would be beneficial to the competition, including adding Trail and Trail-In-Hand as classes that would qualify for the Horsemanship portion of the contest. This particular suggestion was not agreed upon, instead it was then suggested that if those two classes were added, it may as well be open to any and all classes. That was not the intent of the royalty advisor, therefore no additional classes were added to the horsemanship portion of the competition.
  - Application deadline is May 15, 2023. The application can be found on our website or contact Jaime Liestman.

A motion was made by Jaime L. that any official show, excluding 4-H and Fun Shows be can be allowed to show an Arabian Type horse for the Horsemanship qualification portion of the contest. The contestant needs to provide the Royalty Advisor the Show Name, Show Location, Judge(s), Class Name, Date of Show and their placing(s) by October 1st of the contest year. # In Remembrance HENRY WULF

June 30, 1936 - March 30, 2023

Henry and his wife, Loretta owned and lived on a farm near Brainerd with their two daughters, Valerie and Heather, where they raised Arabian horses and all were active in the Northern Minnesota Arabian Horse Association and the North Star Arabian Horse Breeders Futurity Program. Henry was a three-time President of NMAHA and twice the recipient of the NMAHA President's Award. He spent many years promoting and assisting with the Pillager Cup Ride sponsored by NMAHA beginning in the late 1960's. He won the 50- mile Pillager Cup Ride in 1969 and went on to place second at the 100-Mile Kettle Moraine Ridge in Wisconsin the same year with a horse he had raised.

He was also a past-President of the North Star Arabian Horse Breeders. Henry will be greatly missed by the
