Even though I couldn't participate in the classes at the Litchfield NMAHA show, due to a broken foot, I still had fun presenting ribbons.



Rewrite The Stars MB. I had a lot of fun in royalty over the years, and I'm always NMAHA Sweez sad to leave for a year.




I enjoy being in the NMAHA group. I love the Christmas parties the group has.
