Meeting Minutes

December 2022

The meeting was held at the Green Roof Area Center in Paynesville, MN and via Google Meet on December 10, 2022. Prior to the meeting those in attendance enjoyed a potluck. Treasurer Report:

Committee Reports:

May Value Shows:

Mary S. gave an update on the shows

- Entries and the number of stalls reserved were down in 2022 from 2021.
- Dates for 2023
 - Reserved for May 20th and 21st.
- After the holidays, the show committee will meet to discuss the 2023 shows in detail.
- In the future, it will be time to train in someone to take Mary S. and Roz G. place with their commitment and responsibility for and at the show.
 - Mary S. will reach out to Lisa Berhow from Wisconsin to see if she would be available and willing to travel the distance to be the show secretary. It is possible Best Mess program would not then be used.
 - The duties could go to someone additional outside of our club.

June Show:

Lynda F. gave an update on the June show.

- Judges
 - -Clara Bushal, has been asked back for 2023.
 - Lynda will look at contacting a second judge this month.
- 2023 Date
 - -A deposit has been paid for the fairgrounds in for June 3rd.

Youth:

Kaitlyn F. gave an overview on the Youth Program:

- Youth Judging
 - -The NMAHA Team at AHA Nationals finished Reserve Overall in the Youth Judging out of 5 or 6 teams that competed. Congratulations to them!

NEW BUSINESS:

Convention Recap:

- Our club delegates, Lynda F. and Kaitlyn F. gave an overview of the AHA Convention.
 - -Many of the proposed resolutions that were passed didn't result in much discussion; however, there were 4 that were presented and discussed at most all committee meetings, listed below:
 - #5: Main Ring judges are able to be certified to judge Sport Horse under saddle and in-hand at the local shows, not at Regional or National shows. This does not allow the main ring judges to judge dressage classes. This resolution was approved.
 - #6: Altering Tail, more clarification was listed for this resolution and it was approved.
 - #7: Shoe Weight Limits, which would allow for a weight that goes outside of the pad, up to 5 ounces which can be removed. That would give the horse a break from wearing as much weight in a shoe all of the time. This resolution was approved.
 - #8 : Tongue Ties, is permissible in the show ring for driving horses and horses in a double bridle. All disciplines are allowed to tie the tongues in the warm up arena, but only these two exceptions listed above are allowed in the judging arena. This resolution was approved.
- Kaitlyn was recognized and awarded a Regional Volunteer Service Award at the ceremony held at the convention. Congratulations, Kaitlyn!
