

<u>January 2022</u>

- Show Fee/Prize List Schedule
 - Roz G., Mary S. and Kaitlyn F. have worked together on the showbill.
 - -An individual had contacted Mary S. about potentially donating a Championship buckle for the Overall Highpoint Ranch Horse classes. This would more than likely be for the Open Division. Nothing has been finalized yet for this idea.
 - -Both the stalls and shaving fees have increased for 2022. NMAHA is being charged more, therefore exhibitors will be charged more.
 - The Pizza Party is set for Friday night starting at 6:00 PM and will go until the pizza is gone.
 - Horse that are being stalled, but not shown will need to fill out a Non-Horse Show form, so all horses can be accounted for at the show. The same rules will apply as to horses that are being shown.
 - -Exhibitors will be able to pay via credit card at the show. There will be a 4% convenience fee applied.
- Silent Auction
 - -There will be a silent auction again this year. It will be looked into donated the funds to a therapeutic riding program.

-February 19th is going to be National Arabian Horse Day. Since Reflection Farm is an AHA Discovery Farm, perhaps they could promote this day.


Meeting Dates:
