NMAHA October Meeting October 11th, 2025

Attendance: Roz Gilbert, Heather Larson, Lynda Frenchick, Valerie Temp, Mary Smith, Kaitlyn Arnzen, and Taylor Nicholls (youth).

Minutes from the August 2025 meeting we approved, with Mary Smith making the motion and Roz Gilbert with the second. There was no further discussion.

The Treasure Report was given by Valerie Temp. We are still waiting on one person to pay from the May 2025 show. Valerie has had some contact with the person. We did get the check from the other person. There was some discussion around the May Show around expenses and income. Roz Gilbert made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, with a second by Kaitlyn Arnzen. The report was approved.

The May AVS show for 2026 will be May 16-17th in Verndale. Leesa has agreed to do the show again. Need to confirm with Jeff Rutz, announcer and with arena on the dates. Will get judges after US Nationals and get the dates to AHA to confirm.

Pertaining to the June WSCA/ Arabians Unplugged show, there were a couple of discussion points around the different options that we have for the show such as changing dates, combining with another club, or doing a sponsorship (similar to what we have done with Endurance Rides). More will be discussed at the January date.

Ambassador program reminder to get forms sent to Kaitlyn Arnzen. Also need to double check that all forms and rules are on the website.

Royalty had two applicants for the 2026 year. They will finish the application process by the end of October or beginning part of November. The crowning will take place during the December meeting.

Delegates have been registered for the National Convention by the Early Bird deadline. Kaitlyn Arnzen and Lynda Frenchick will be our delegates.

Lynda Frenchick presented the Presidents award to Heather Larson for her work with doing the awards at our May show over the years.

Discussed the budget for 2026, with little being changed from the 2025 budget. Kaitlyn Arnzen made a motion to increase the budget for endurance sponsorships. \$150 will be given to a qualifying ride and \$250 given to the AHA US National Ride. Roz Gilbert made the second. Motion was approved.
