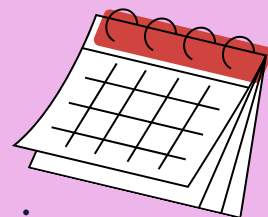

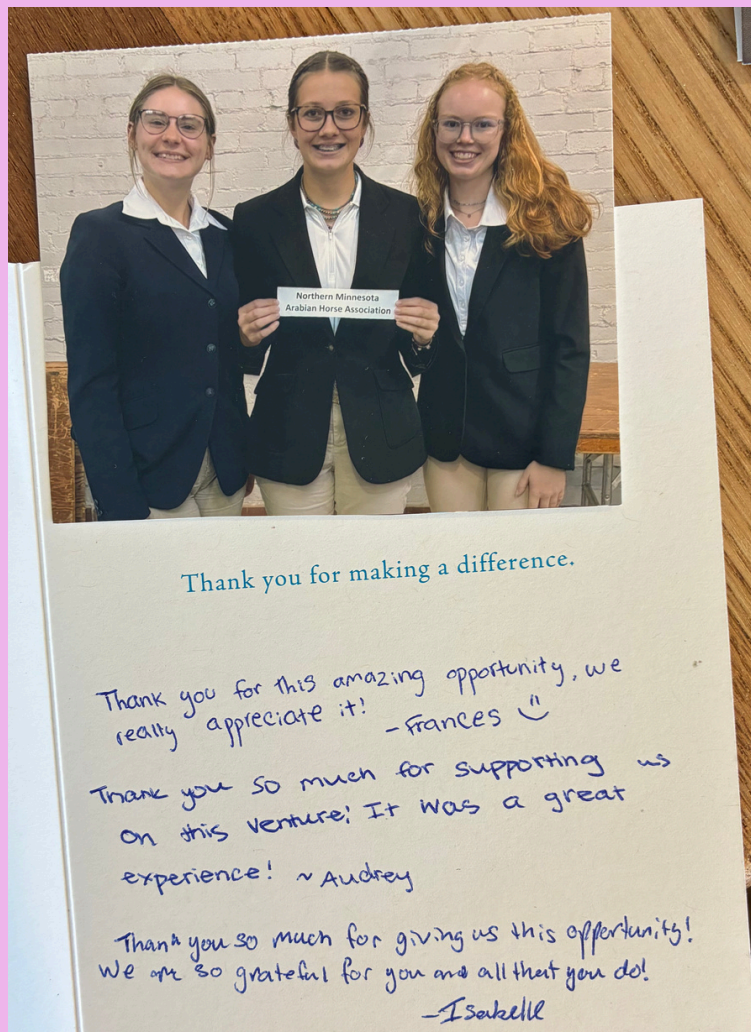

NMAHA October Meeting December 13th, 2025

Attendance: Lynda Frenchick, Valerie Temp, Kaitlyn Arnzen, Penny Lindblom, Tina Nicholls (guest), Taylor Nicholls (youth), and Audrey Frenchick (youth).

Minutes from the October 2025 meeting we approved, with Penny Lindblom making the motion and Valerie Temp with the second. There was no further discussion.

In keeping with tradition, there was no treasure report given at the December Meeting.

The May AVS show for 2026 will be May 16-17th in Verndale. Leesa has agreed to do the show again. Need to confirm with Jeff Rutz, announcer and with arena on the dates. We have confirmed one of the Judges.

Pertaining to the June WSCA/ Arabians Unplugged show, we have the facility for 2026 and have 1 judge lined up. Lynda proposed to combine with the 4H club to run it under our name and the club would make a donation to the Meeker County 4H horse project. Valerie will check on insurance. Some items were discussed in what happens if the 4Hers do not help volunteering, would need to adjust the show bill to fit more of a traditional open show schedule. More will be discussed at the January meeting.

Programs had at least one person per category and age group. Kaitlyn will be going through the rules and forms to make sure they are all ready to go January 1.

The different groups we sponsored for the Hippology/Judging contest this past fall gave a report of their success. We sponsored three different trips.

Kaitlyn Arnzen and Lynda Frenchick gave an update from different items that came up during the National Convention. The restructuring resolution passed. The other hot topic was around USEF and if we should continue to use them as our governing body. We also discussed micro-chipping, which is required for any USEF show starting December 1, 2025.

Lynda also brought up trying to get a show or two to move to July to help fill the void of shows in the Minnesota area.

We set our 2026 Meeting dates for the following:

Lynda will confirm that the Area Center is available for the March and April dates.
